How the impact of the fund on educational attainment will be assessed?

Pupils have been assessed and identified as needing to catch up lost ground compared

through formative and summative assessment in the following subjects:

Maths, Reading (phonics (KS1) and comprehension (KS2) and writing. Autumn term.

Pre-teaching to also focus on vocabulary in Science, History and Geography from

Spring Term.

Pupils will be assessed periodically to check that they are making up lost ground.

Assessment will be by using teacher judgement using formative assessment strategies.

Summative assessments will take place at the end of each half term.

The ELSA Profiles will be used in order to assess the progress of the children receiving

Nurture interventions and also to identify children who require more intensive one to one support.

Pupil Progress meetings and well-being/ welfare meetings will focus on attainment and progress of all children, but particularly children who are receiving targeted support.
