Things have continued to move at pace at the start of the term and the children are certainly being kept busy in class with lots of good learning and new topics. I am pleased that we are able to continue to provide a full and thorough offer for all of our children despite the challenges and continued trickle of COVID cases.

It is really important that you are aware of recent changes to the isolation period. The isolation period is now 5 full days from the date of a positive test – the day of the test is day 0. If your child tests negative on a LFT on days 5 and 6 they can return to school on day 6 (these tests must be done at least 24 hours apart and taken in the morning, to enable your child to come to school).

As the weather is still very cold, please make sure your child has a suitable coat. Our school uniform is adequate as clothing under your child's coat. A reminder that leggings and skinny jeans are not part of our school uniform and should not be worn. If you can ensure that any items are clearly labelled it makes returning any 'lost' items much, much easier and thank you for your help with this in advance.

Wednesday 2nd March is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. As we begin our preparation for Easter, we will keep you in our prayers
